



14 DAYS NEPAL (ABC TREK)

Highlights: 3 Nights Kathmandu, 2 Nights Chitwan, 2 Nights Pokhara,
6 Nights 7 Days Annapurna Trekking

DAY 01: SINGAPORE - KATHMANDU

Arrival in international airport meet by our representative, Welcome garland, welcome drinks, check in hotel, rest for a while, lunch, after lunch visit **Boudhanath**: - It is the world's biggest Stupa located about 2 kilometers to the north of Pashupatinath temple. The Colossal Stupa is known by the name of Boudhanath, the god of wisdom. It is difficult to assign a period to it, as some believe that it was built during the reign of either Shiva Dev or Anshu Verma in the 7th Century AD. Boudhanath attracts the Buddhist pilgrims from all over the world, **Pashupatinath** It is one of the holiest Hindu shrines in the world. The temple is dedicated to lord Shiva and is built in the familiar Pagoda Style. Chronicles indicate the temple's existence prior to 400 AD. This holy place is picturesque collection of temples and shrines. All the dying persons are brought to Pashupatinath for the cremation. Only the Hindus are allowed to go inside the temple, dinner, transfer to hotel, overnight in Kathmandu

DAY 02: KATHMANDU - CHITWAN

Breakfast, drive to Chitwan check in resort briefing about jungle activities, tharu village visit by ox- cart, dinner and Overnight in Chitwan.

DAY 03: CHITWAN

Early morning elephant ride, nature walk including bird watching breakfast, Canoe Ride on Rapti River lunch, elephant breeding and feeding center, B.B.Q dinner with campfire and Overnight in Chitwan.

DAY 04: CHITWAN - POKHARA

Breakfast, drive to Pokhara, check in hotel, lunch rest for a while then sightseeing to David's fall, Gupteshwor cave, Dinner, Overnight in Pokhara.

DAY 5: POKHARA - NAYAPUL 1070 M - TIRKHEDHUNGA 1540 M

Breakfast drive to Nayapul, about 2 hours, start trekking to Tirkhedhunga, 3-4 hours, Lunch, continue trekking, dinner, overnight in lodge.

DAY 6: TIRKHEDHUNGA 1540 M - GHOREPANI 3194 M

Breakfast start trekking to Ghorepani about 4-5 hours, lunch, continue trek, dinner, overnight in lodge.

DAY 7: GHOREPANI 3194 M - POONHILL 3210 M - TADAPANI 2590 M

Breakfast trek to Poonhill for 1 hour, lunch, continue to Tadapani, about Tadapani, dinner, overnight in lodge.

DAY 8: TADAPANI 2590 M - CHOMRUNG 2170 M

B/L/D

Breakfast trek to Chomrung, about 5 - 6 hours, lunch, continue dinner, overnight in lodge.

DAY 9: CHOMRUNG 2170 M - JHINUDADA 1780 M - LANDRUK 1640 M

Breakfast start trekking to Jhinudada about 1 hour, lunch, continue trekking Landruk for 3-4 hours dinner, overnight in Landruk.

DAY 10: LANDRUK 1640M - POTHANA 1890 M

Breakfast start trekking to Pothana, about 3-4 hours lunch continue trekking dinner, overnight in Lodge.

DAY 11: POTHANA 1890 M - DAMPUS 1770 M- PHEDI - POKHARA

Breakfast start trekking to Dhampus, about 2 - 3 hours continue to Phedi for 1 hour and drive to Pokhara for 1 hour, dinner, overnight in Pokhara.

DAY 12: POKHARA - KATHMANDU

Breakfast drive to Kathmandu, lunch, Visit **Bhaktapur Durbar Square**: - The Durbar Square (the palace complex) in the central part of Bhaktapur depicts the art and architecture of the Malla rule. The Palace of Fifty - five windows stand in the square was the home to many kings of Bhaktapur. Among other monuments around the Durbar Square are worth visiting, dinner in Chinese restaurant, overnight in Kathmandu.



DAY 13: KATHMANDU

Breakfast visit **Patan Durbar Square**: - It is an enchanting mélange of palace buildings, artistic courtyards and graceful pagoda temples. This Square was the former Royal Palace Complex which was the center of Patan's religious and social life, and houses a museum containing an array of bronze statues and religious monuments. One remarkable monument here is 17th Century temple dedicated to the Hindu god Krishna, built entirely of stone, lunch, after lunch visit, **Swoyambhunath Stupa**: - The Swoyambhunath Stupa crowns a hillock to the west of Kathmandu. A massive white dome surrounded by a 13 stage spire, the Stupa is one of the most sacred Buddhist sites in Nepal. It is said to be 2000 years old. Its origin is linked to the founding of the Kathmandu Valley, draining the water out of the lake by bodhisattva Manjushree. Swoyambhunath Manifested in the lake as a brilliant light emanating from a lotus and Manjushree let the water out by slashing a passage through the surrounding hills to facilitate paying homage to Swoyambhu, thus making the valley inhabitable, **Kathmandu Durbar Square**: - It is an overwhelming frenzy of art and architecture. The medieval palace complex is erected in different styles at the right hand side of the Kumari temple. The house of Kumari (living goddess), the ferocious Kal Bhairab, the red monkey god and hundreds of erotic carvings are a few examples of the sights at the square! All wood carvings, statues and architecture in this area are exceptionally fine the evening visit Indrachowk, old market, Ason, and free for shopping in Thamel, farewell dinner in Nepali Chulo Restaurant with culture show and overnight in Kathmandu

DAY 14: KATHMANDU - SINGAPORE

Breakfast transfer to airport for the final departure as per flight schedule
