



Cambodia Tours 06Days 5Nights REP-PNH

(Tour Code: PTMCAM8)

Day 1: SIN-REP (-/L/D) Arrival Siem Reap airport, pick up and transfer to your hotel, visit the floating village of **Chong Khneas**, located 10 kilometers south of Siem Reap. Take a traditional wooden boat for a ride on the **Tonle Sap Lake**, the "Great Lake" of Cambodia, one of the largest in Asia. Lunch at restaurant Afternoon visit the **Cambodian Cultural Village**: A unique, sprawling cultural attraction, intended to introduce the visitor to Cambodian culture and history. Interesting wax museum features scenes and figures from history.

Day 2: REP (B/L/D) Breakfast at hotel, in the morning, visit the ancient capital of **Angkor Thom** (12th c.), See the **South Gate** with its hugestatues depicting the churning of the ocean of milk, the **Royal Enclosure**, **Phimeanakas**, the **Elephants Terrace**, the **Terrace of the Leper King** and **Bayon Temple** (unique for its 54 towers decorated with over 200 smiling faces of Avolokitesvara), **Ta Prohm Temple** of similar design to the Jayavarman VII temples, this quiet sprawling monastic complex is only partially cleared of jungle overgrowthLunch at restaurant Afternoon visit the most famous of all the temples on the plain of Angkor: **Angkor Wat**. The temple complex covers 81 hectares and is comparable in size to the Imperial Palace in Beijing. Its distinctive five towers are emblazoned on theCambodian flag and the 12th century masterpiece is considered by art historians to be the prime example of classical Khmer art and architecture and view **sunset at Bakheng Mountain**.

Day 3: REP (B/L/D) Breakfast at hotel, in the morning, visit to "**Les Artisans d'Angkor - Chantiers Ecoles**" of Siem Reap renowned woodworking, stone carving and polychrome workshops and **Angkor silk farm** where collated in Puok, 16 km from Siem Reap, exhibition on silk and its process. Lunch at local restaurant Afternoon proceed for a tour of their **local Markets, Crocodile Farm** and enjoy a **Traditional Khmer massage**

Day 4: REP-PNH (B/L/D)Breakfast at the hotel, transfer to Phnom Penh by **public coach** (Approximately 5-6 hours), up on arrival pick up and transfer to your lunch before check in your hotel, visit the **Independent Monument**, and the **National Museum**, also called Musee des Beaux-Arts. A French archaeologist and painter, Georges Groslier, designed it in Khmer style in 1917. The museum contains a collection of Khmer art - notably sculptures – from throughout the ages, the **Royal Palace**, built by King Norodom in 1866 on the site of the old town, and the **Silver Pagoda**. Located within the grounds of the Royal Palace, the Silver Pagoda is so named because of its floor, which is made up of 5000 silver tiles and the **Sisowath Quay & Naga World Casino**

Day 5: PNH (B/L/D) Breakfast at hotel, visit to the **Wat Phnom** Temple, Phnom Penh's namesake, from where you can enjoy views over the tree-lined avenues of the city and the Notorious **Tuol Sleng Museum**, In 1975 Tuol Svay Prey High School was taken over by Pol Pot's security forces and turned into a prison known as Security Prison 21 (S-21) Lunch at restaurant Visit the **Killing Fields of Choeng EK** just outside Phnom Penh about a 20-40 minute was an orchard and a Chinese cemetery prior to 1975. During the Khmer Rouge regime it became one of the killing fields and the **Russian Market** (Psah Tuol Thom Pong), a lively outdoor market where you will find antiquities, silver and gold jewelry, gems, silk, kramas, stone and wood carvings, as well as T-Shirts, CDs and other souvenirs

Day 6: PNH-SIN (B/-/-)

Breakfast at the hotel, transfer to airport for departure.
