



04Days 03Nights Cambodia Tour PNH-REP

(Tour Code: PTMPS4D3N)



Day 1: SIN-PNH (-/L/D) Pick up from airport and transfer to your hotel, visit the **Independent Monument**, and the **Royal Palace**, built by King Norodom in 1866 on the site of the old town, and the **Silver Pagoda**. Located within the grounds of the Royal Palace, the Silver Pagoda is so named because of its floor, which is made up of 5000 silver tiles. Visit of the **Wat Phnom Temple**, Phnom Penh's namesake, from where you can enjoy views over the tree-lined avenues of the city. Lunch at restaurant Afternoon, visit the Notorious **Tuol Sleng Museum**, In 1975 Tuol Svay Prey High School was taken over by Pol Pot's security forces and turned into a prison known as Security Prison 21 (S-21) and the **Russian Market** (Psah Tuol Thom Pong), a lively outdoor market where you will find antiquities, silver and gold jewelry, gems, silk, kramas, stone and wood carvings, as well as T-Shirts, CDs and other souvenirs. Dinner at restaurant and accommodation at hotel

Day 2: PNH-REP (B/L/D) Breakfast at the hotel, transfer to Siem Reap by **public coach** (Approximately 5-6 hours), upon arrival pick up and transfer to have your lunch before check in your hotel, visit the floating village of **Chong Khneas**, located 10 kilometers south of Siem Reap. Take a traditional wooden boat for a ride on the **Tonle Sap Lake**, the "Great Lake" of Cambodia, one of the largest in Asia. Visit "**Les Artisans d'Angkor - Chantiers Ecoles**" of Siem Reap and time at leisure at the **local market** Dinner with **dance show** at local restaurant and accommodation at hotel

Day 3: REP (B/L/D) Breakfast at hotel, in the morning, half day **Tuk Tuk ride** to visit the ancient capital of **Angkor Thom** (12th c.), See the **South Gate** with its huge statues depicting the churning of the ocean of milk, the **Royal Enclosure**, **Phimeanakas**, the **Elephants Terrace**, the **Terrace of the Leper King** and **Bayon Temple** (unique for its 54 towers decorated with over 200 smiling faces of Avolokitesvara), Ta **Prohm Temple** of similar design to the Jayavarman VII temples, this quiet sprawling monastic complex is only partially cleared of jungle overgrowth. Intentionally left partially unrestored, massive fig and silk cotton trees grow from the towers and corridors offering some of the best 'tree-in temple' photo opportunities at Angkor Wat Lunch at restaurant Visit the most famous of all the temples on the plain of Angkor: **Angkor Wat**. The temple complex covers 81 hectares and is comparable in size to the Imperial Palace in Beijing. Its distinctive five towers are emblazoned on the Cambodian flag and the 12th century masterpiece is considered by art historians to be the prime example of classical Khmer art and architecture. Angkor Wat's five towers symbolize Meru's five peaks - the enclosed wall represents the mountains at the edge of the world and the surrounding moat, the ocean beyond until **sunset at Bakheng Mountain**. Dinner local restaurant and accommodation at hotel

Day 4: REP-SIN (B/-/-)

Breakfast at the hotel, transfer to airport for departure.
