

九天青藏高原铁路逍遥之旅



第一天：新加坡—成都

宿成都

(晚餐)

齐集樟宜机场搭乘豪华客机前往成都。游览著名的成都大熊猫繁育研究基地和锦里民俗文化村。成都熊猫基地是为保护拯救珍稀濒危动物大熊猫而兴建的具有世界先进水平的科研机构，基地模拟大熊猫及多种珍稀野生动物生息繁衍野外生态环境，竹木苍翠，鸟语花香，景观优美。

第二天：成都—拉萨，贡嘎机场接机敬献哈达欣赏尼塘大佛，高原气候适应性休息。

宿拉萨

(早午晚餐)

飞抵海拔约 3600 米的拉萨贡嘎机场，导游接机敬献哈达，沿世界最高的河流—雅鲁藏布江逆流而上驱车 100 公里前往拉萨。途中停车观赏建于十一世纪的尼塘大佛。拉萨是一座有着 1300 多年历史的古城，是西藏政治、经济、文化、宗教的中心。由于拉萨一年的日照时间很长，故被称为日光城。抵拉萨后作高原适应性休息。

第三天：拉萨游览布达拉宫、大昭寺、八角街。

宿拉萨

(早午晚餐)

上午参观坐落在市中心红山上达赖喇嘛的冬宫，当今世界海拔最高的古代宫堡式建筑群—布达拉宫，布达拉梵语意为观世音圣地，为自公元七世纪以来历世达赖喇嘛驻地和西藏政教权力的中心。下午前往藏传佛教信徒心中的圣地—吐蕃古寺大昭寺，接着赴拉萨最热闹的八角街手工艺品市场游览，浏览和选购各式充满民族特色和异域风情的手制品。

第四天：拉萨翻越那根拉雪山游览天湖纳木错，羊八井地热景区自费沐浴温泉。

宿拉萨

(早午晚餐)

拉萨出发经青藏公路翻越那根拉雪山前往面积 1920 平方公里，世界上海拔最高的咸水湖纳木错（海拔 4718 米）。纳木错湖滨广阔、水草丰美，清澈壮观，像一粒晶莹的明珠般镶嵌在万里羌塘草原上。返回拉萨途中远眺终年积雪的念青唐古拉山，游览羊八井地热景区，在雪山环绕之中自费沐浴温泉。感受蓝天白云雪峰下藏北草原苍茫辽阔的自然风光。

第五天：拉萨—江孜—日喀则，观赏羊卓雍湖，卡惹拉冰川，游览白居寺十万佛塔。

宿日喀则

(早午晚餐)

拉萨启程翻越海拔 4900 米的冈巴拉雪山，远眺冈巴拉雷达站，前往世界上最高的淡水湖有天上圣湖之美誉的羊卓雍湖。清澈的湖水、巍峨的雪山和如洗的蓝天融为一体，陶醉、震撼并涤荡着你的灵魂。观赏世纪冰川卡惹拉冰川，环绕羊卓雍湖前往电影《红河谷》外景地—江孜。参观唯一集西藏三大教派于一体，以精美绝伦的壁画和雕刻而著称的十万佛塔白居寺，远眺宗山抗英炮台后赴后藏重镇—日喀则。

第六天：日喀则游览扎什伦布寺，班禅大师灵塔，沿雅鲁藏布江河谷返回拉萨。

宿拉萨

(早午晚餐)

上午参观班禅大师灵魂安息地、黄教六大寺之一的扎什伦布寺。扎什伦布寺由一世达赖喇嘛根顿珠巴主持修建于 1447 年，后成为历代班禅额尔德尼驻锡地。寺内供奉有高 28 米世界上最大的铜佛坐像—“强巴佛”即弥勒佛像。瞻仰十世班禅大师灵塔。下午沿雅鲁藏布江回拉萨，沿途欣赏雅鲁藏布江草地峡谷、后藏大漠风光。

第七天：拉萨—西宁：搭乘世界海拔最高的青藏铁路专线列车前往西宁。

宿火车

(早餐)

早餐后搭乘世界海拔最高的青藏铁路专线列车前往西宁，拉萨—当雄—那曲—安多—沱沱河—格尔木—西宁。沿着世界海拔最高、里程最长、景色最壮观的高原铁路，走过羌塘草原、错那湖、唐古拉山、可可西里、昆仑山、青海湖和戈壁红柳长江源，在风驰电掣般奔驰的铁路列车中观赏全景画般的青藏高原雪域风光，以及在广袤的原野上奔腾撒欢的藏羚羊、野牦牛。备注参考时间：拉萨—西宁全长 1956KM，青藏铁路专线火车上午发车，次日中午抵达西宁，全程行驶约计 25 小时。

第八天：拉萨—西宁—青海湖（160KM）—西宁。

宿西宁

(午晚餐)

乘火车抵达高原明珠城市—西宁。接着沿唐朝文成公主进藏的唐蕃古道观赏日月山，日亭，月亭，倒淌河，感受黄土高原与青藏高原、汉文化与藏文化的分界线，接着乘船游览面积 4500 多平方公里（10 月中旬—4 月中旬游船停运），我国最大的内陆咸水湖—青海湖。青海湖湖面碧波万顷，湖畔草原辽阔，雪山巍峨，充满诗情画意而又无比壮丽辉煌。

第九天：西宁—成都—新加坡（B）

上午参观藏传佛教六大寺院之一，宗喀巴大师的诞生地，以堆绣、壁画、酥油花“艺术三绝”闻名遐迩，气势恢弘的塔尔寺。接着游览西北四大清真寺之一的东关清真大寺。东关清真大寺建筑宏伟壮观，同时兼具藏汉风格，风格为国内清真寺所仅有。浏览高原城市独特风光后前往机场乘机飞离西宁，中转成都，搭乘豪华客机返回美丽的家园—新加坡，

GV6 **9 D Scenic Skyway Tour of Qinhai-Tibet Plateau** ZP-2

Day.1 Singapore-Chengdu. (D)

Chengdu city, covers Chengdu Panda Research Base and Jinli Folk Cultural Village. The Chengdu Panda Research Base is a highlight for the Chengdu tour. Its purpose is to enlarge the number of Panda bears and reintroduce the Pandas in to nature. After the visiting you will have a deep knowledge of the lovely pandas.

Day.2 Chengdu-Lhasa. (B/L/D)

Fly to Lhasa in the morning. Our guide will meet you at Konggar Airport, and transfer you to Lhasa city with about two hours' driving (100km). On the way, you'll get greeted by Nie Tang Buddha - a Buddha image engraved in the mountain face. After arrive in Lhasa, rest and acclimatize. Overnight in Lhasa.

Day.3 Lhasa. (B/L/D)

You'll have a whole day of sightseeing in the holy city: in the morning, visit Lhasa's landmark - Potala Palace, a structure that deserves a place as one of the wonders of eastern architecture. In the afternoon, visit Jokhang Temple - the most revered religious structure in Tibet, and the surrounding area - Barkhor, Lhasa's pilgrimage circuit. This area is both the spiritual heart of Lhasa and the main commercial district for Tibetans. Overnight in Lhasa.

Day.4 Lhasa-Namco-Lhasa. (B/L/D)

You'll start the excursion to Namco on this day. Drive through the Qiangtang Plain, look over Nyaiqen Tanglha mountain range, occasionally you'll encounter herds of yaks and bharals, finally reach the Sky Lake. Later on the way back to Lhasa, you will visit the world-famous Yagpachen Geothermal Zone, and pay to take a hot spring bath. Overnight in Lhasa.

Day.5 Lhasa-Yamdrotso-Shigatse. (B/L/D)

Drive 110km to visit Yamdrotso - one of the three holy lakes in Tibet. It's winding road all up to the mountain, bumpy and somewhat thrilling. After pass over the Kambala pass of 5030m, the lake finally appears. Seen from the summit of Kambala pass, the lake is a fabulous shade of deep turquoise. After down from the mountain, there's about 30km road along lakeside, with barley fields on the other side of the road. A nice walk by the lakeside can be a great joy. Leaving Yamdrotso is as spectacular as arriving, since you'll cross the 5045m Karola, with its awesome roadside views of the Nojin Kangtsang Glacier. In the afternoon, you'll go to Gyantse, visit Kumbum Monastery there. After that you'll drive about two hours (100km) to Shigatse. Overnight in Shigatse.

Day.6 Shigatse-Lhasa. (B/L/D)

In the morning, you'll drive to visit the residence of Panchen Lama- Tashilunpo Monastery. After visiting this magnificent monastery and having lunch at Shigatse, you'll go back to Lhasa along the Yarlong Tseangpo River, enjoy the great landscape en route. Overnight in Lhasa.

Day.7 Lhasa - Xining (B)

Take the train to Xi'ning: We will take the Qinghai-Tibet train whole day to Xi'ning. The route: Lhasa-Damxung-Nagqu-Amdo-Tuotuo River- Gelmud-Xi'ning. (The meals on the train will be covered by yourself). Over night on the train

Day.8 Xining (L/D)

After 26 hrs traveling, today we will arrive Xi'ning, pearl of Qinghai-Tibet Plateau. Railway Station and transfer to hotel. Then we will experience the difference between Loess Plateau and Qinghai-Tibet Plateau, as well as between Chinese and Tibetan culture by long distance view of the well-known Ri Yue Mountain, Ri Pavilion and Yue Pavilion and DaoTang River. Another highlight of the day is famous Qinghai Lake (Koko Nor) which is the biggest inland salt lake in China. It's a somewhat surreal-looking saline lake, the largest lake in China and contains huge numbers of fish. Kumbum(Ta'er) Monastery is one of the six great monasteries of the Gelugpa sect of Tibetan Buddhism. The monastery is noted for its extraordinary art of yak butter sculpture, fresco and embroidery. Overnight in Xi'ning

Day.9 Xining – Chengdu - Singapore (B)

This morning, you'll go to visit the Grand Dongguan Mosque one of the biggest mosque in Northwest of China . After the excursion of the highland city pack your luggage, and get ready for leaving. The guide will transfer you to the airport, and help you board the plane. Say goodbye to Tibet.
