



9D8N Golden Triangle with Kashmir **Delhi - Srinagar - Jaipur - Agra**

DAY 01: SINGAPORE - DELHI (NO MEAL)

Arrive in India's bustling capital city of Delhi and let the experience begin! A traditional Indian welcome marks the start of your magnificent journey before escorted to your hotel, spend your evening relaxing after your long flight. Overnight stay at the hotel

DAY 02: DELHI TO SRINAGAR (B L D)

Fly to Srinagar, famously known as Paradise on Earth a multi-faceted diamond, changing its hues with the seasons. It tells the story of love that Mughal Emperors had for this paradise like vale with deep green rice fields, rivers, gardens in bloom and lakes rimmed by houseboats

Today's tour of Srinagar includes the Mughal Gardens, created by the famous Mughal Emperors, situated on the banks Dal-Lake in the backdrop of Zabarwan hills encircles the Lake. Overnight stay at the houseboats

DAY 03: GULMARG EXCURSION (B L D)

A day excursion to Gulmarg by surface, exquisitely situated in a pine surrounded basin of the Pir Panjal range at an altitude of 2730 meters above sea level, discovered by the British in the 19th century and has the world's highest green golf courses with 18 holes. Enjoy a pony ride through pine-clad slopes which leads upwards to Khilanmarg, Kangdori & seven springs Overnight stay at the houseboats

DAY 04: SRINAGAR TO JAIPUR (VIA) DELHI (B L D)

Today early morning, enjoy one of the most soothing & relaxing Shikara ride on the lake. Fly back to Delhi, where upon arrival you will depart by surface for the "pink city" of Jaipur, the old city is surrounded by a massive wall pierced by magnificent gates. Spend your evening relaxing after your full-day long journey.

Overnight stay at the hotel

DAY 05: SIGHTSEEING IN JAIPUR (B L D)

Today, you are transported back in time, riding royally atop elegantly draped and painted elephants to the mountain fortress of Amber, a superb example of Rajput architecture with its complex of palaces, temples and ornate apartments.

This afternoon's tour of Jaipur takes you to drive past Hawa Mahal or "Palace of Winds" and continues to City Palace, with its latticed balconies, tiny windows, cupolas, courtyards and arched entrances. A stop at the ancient observatory concludes the tour.

DAY 06: JAIPUR TO AGRA (VIA) FATEHPUR SIKRI (B L D)

Today morning you will depart by surface for Agra, en route visiting Emperor Akbar's 16th century abandoned city of Fatehpur Sikri. This ghost town is remarkably well preserved and presents a perfect synthesis of Muslim, Hindu and Jain architecture. The sculptured columns bear mute testimony to this gallant experiment to unite Hindus and Muslims.

In the afternoon, explore the 16th century Agra Fort with its battlements, apartments, gardens and audience halls. This powerful fortress of red sandstone encompasses, within its 2.5-km-long enclosure walls, the imperial city of the Mughal rulers. Enjoy an extended visit to the magnificent Taj Mahal known as the most opulent wonder of the modern world and witness its transformation as the monument reflects the warm glow of sunset.

DAY 07: AGRA TO DELHI (B L D)

This morning you will depart by surface for Delhi, upon arrival check-in at the hotel.

Continue on to the capital city of Delhi; where upon arrival embark on a tour of New Delhi, where ornate buildings recall the days when India was the gem in the crown of the British Empire. Drive along Rajpath, the capital's broadest avenue, for a view of the Parliament House, the President's House and India Gate (War Memorial Arch). Visit the Qutab Minar built by Qutub-ud-Din Aibek in 1199 from sandstone and marble.

DAY 08 SIGHTSEEING IN DELHI (B L D)

This morning's guided sightseeing tour of the Old Delhi includes the drive past of Red Fort, visit Jamia Masjid, Raj Ghat - a memorial to Mahatma Gandhi, Ashoka Pillar and the mile-long Chandni Chowk bazaar.

The afternoon is at leisure to relax, pursue independent activities and last minute shopping opportunity.
